## ANYONE FOR WELDING?

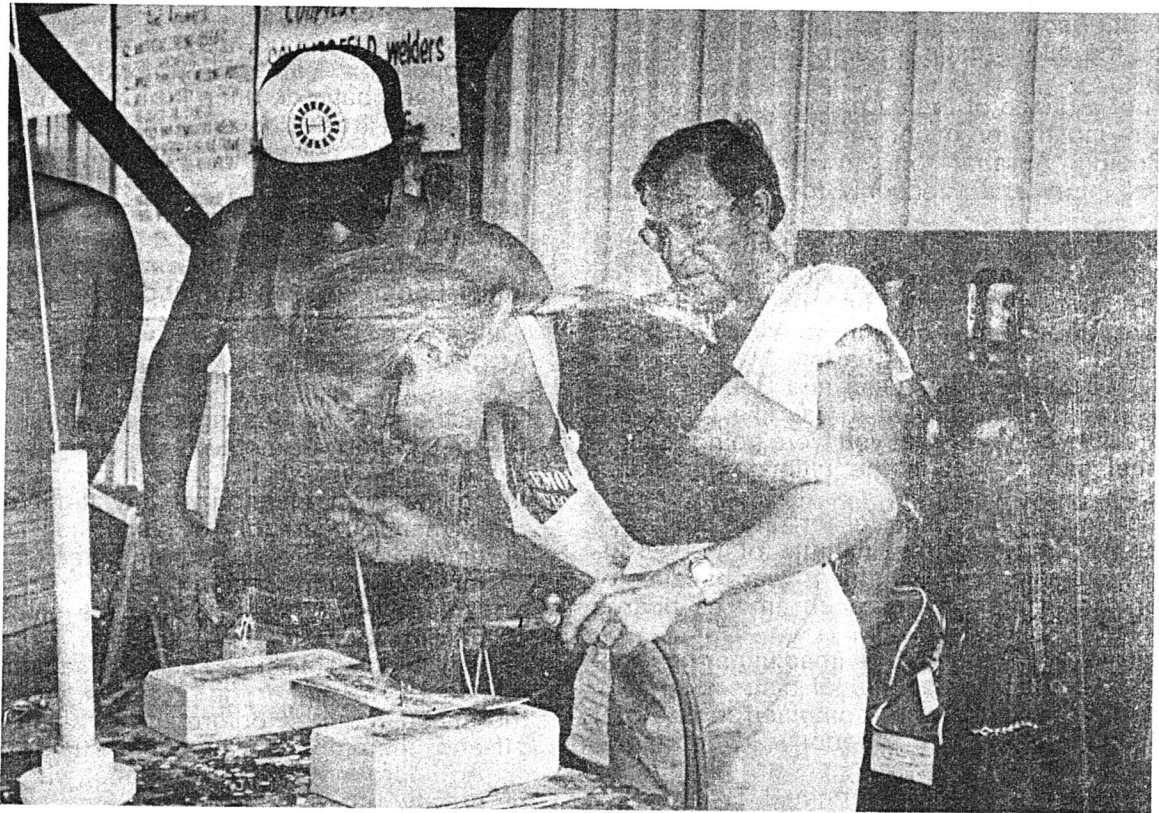
